





OBJECTIVES:


- Reducing the amount of materials in landfills and promoting conditions that make it possible

- Minimize the Production of Waste. Proper management practices help minimize the garbage and scraps that need handling.
- Nearly 120 tons of municipal waste is being converted to organic manure which is around 4mm size.




